Our Location: an Environmental very Sensitive Area

- The site borders a town called Riva del Garda (Trento Province), in a flat area sloping down towards the northern end of **Lake Garda**.
- In recent decades, urban development has heavily affected inland lake areas, and this has practically absorbed the production site; **residential areas** surround the paper mill.
- This area has seen a strong development of **recreational-touristy activities**, with the town of Riva del Garda attracting many tourists from Italy and abroad.

Being aware of its responsibility towards the surrounding communities and the territory where it is located, Cartiere del Garda pursues its **commitment to the environment** with great determination.

Fibrous Raw Materials

A great deal of attention is paid to the selection of the raw materials, which must originate from **certified or well-managed forests and plantations** (in accordance to the specific requirements of FSC and

PEFC standards).



It means that Cartiere del Garda controls its sources to exclude the following categories:

- a) wood harvested from forest areas where traditional or civil rights are violated;
- b) wood harvested from forest areas having high conservation values which are threatened;
- c) wood harvested from genetically modified (GM) trees;
- d) illegally harvested wood;
- e) natural forest that has been converted to plantations or non-forest use.
